- Lumbar/Cervical/Thoracic Facet Radiofrequency ablation(RFA) for Back pain/localised pain/Facet arthropathy/Headache
- Lumbar/Thoracic Sympathetic block/RFA for RSD ie CRPS type 1 and 2, Vascular pain of lower limbs and chest or Neuralgic pain.
- Stellate block/RFA for upper limb CRPS or Vascular pain or Neuralgic pain
- Trigeminal Ganglion RFA
- Sphenopalatine/Occipital block/RFA for Headache/Atypical facial pain
- Celiac/Superior Hypogastric RFA/Neurolysis for Cancer pain

- Spinal Cord stimulator/Intathecal Implantable pump for resistant pain conditions
- Various simpler nerve blocks, Trigger point injections for Various painful conditions
