

## **ISSP UPDATES**

- Star Health policy for insurance coverage. At present, only 14 procedures are included in Interventional pain management category by star health. We are pursuing the matter further with Star insurance to incorporate all the listed procedures under insurance cover.
  We had hired a consultant, Mr. Manivannan, to liaison with Insurance agencies, to bring two companies onboard. We have re-initiated the talks with him to bring other insurance companies to cover all the listed pain procedures under insurance cover. He was reminded that as per the agreement, he had to liaison with at least 2 insurance companies.
- Indemnity insurance by Cover U. They are ready to give indemnity cover for all 140 procedures (plus any procedure that will be added in future) listed in ISSP coding document. We will be sending soft copy of the Tie-up letter to all members through email and will officially launch the policy on ISSP Foundation Day, i.e. 9 <sup>th</sup>of July 2023.
- The Secretariat is following up for list of procedures to be included in the Ayushman Bharat policy with competent authorities.
- We are upgrading the UI of our website and adding new pages in the form of patient education initiatives. We have hired an agency for making patient awareness videos and handouts which will be uploaded on our website and You Tube channel. The videos will be in English and Hindi and handouts will be published in 8 regional languages.
- IASP Conference representation was done by Dr. Pradeep Jain, Prof. Ashok Saxena, Dr. Jeetinder, Dr Babita Ghai Dr. Hammad Usmani. Prof Ashok Saxena was bestowed with IASP award for excellence in Pain research in developing countries.
- New member addition: Total number of ISSP members till 30<sup>th</sup>April 2023 stands at 3096. The new members of ISSP that will join ISSP after the date of notification of elections will not be able to vote that year in AGBM. This is for the information of all the members.
- Twitter account (@issphq) has been started by ISSP Secretariat and we request all members to follow it.
- ISSP Newsletter will now be released twice in a year, instead of once.



### ... ISSP UPDATES

- Two new branches have been formed this year, Raipur and Gurugram. We congratulate the founding members of these branches for the same. As of today we have 20 city branches and 11 state chapters.
- A Condemnation committee was formed and members of the committee will be Vice President, Past Secretary, Treasurer, Joint Secretary and senior most members of GC (any three out of five) along with President and Secretary
- The current GC members body has been updated to IASP and SARPS.
- Hon. Secretary Dr Pravesh Kanthed met Honorable Gov. of Govt. of Assam H.E. Shri Gulab Chand Kataria for matter related to inclusion of DM< Pain Medicine as a super-specialty of Anaesthesiology. The Hon. Gov. guided us to meet MP from Indore, Mr Shankar Lalwani to help fix a meeting with Mr Mansukh Mandaviya, Minister for Health and Family Welfare. We are following up with him and will soon represent our case to Health Minister.
- ISSP Registration renewal was due on 8th May 2023 at Varanasi. We have applied for the renewal and furnished all the documents required for the same. Dr Anil Paswan is assisting the Secretariat and we are thankful to him for the same.
- Database mining and updation was done. 216 member names were found in old registers and receipt books, which were missing in the software. We have updated their names in the software. We have also informed chapter/branch Secretaries to share updated members details with headquarters.
- Constitution review committee under Dr. Muralidhar Joshi has given their final draft, it will be posted on website after finalizing it.





### ... ISSP UPDATES

- ISSP Secretariat urges state chapter/ city branch President and Secretary to conduct a GBM annually and elections, no later than three years as is mandated by our constitution. To maintain uniformity across the country, the elections should be held in the month of December, so that the new executive council takes over by Jan. and represent their respective Chapter/ Branch in ISSPCON in Feb. The minutes of the meeting and activities done by the chapter/ branch should be communicated with the Secretariat so that they can be published in the newsletter. Annual returns of the society should be filed with the tax authorities and a copy of audited accounts should be sent to the Secretariat for their record.
- To maintain uniformity ISSP Helpline number is generated as +91-8889998301. Whats app communications will be available on the same. This number will be passed from Secretary to Secretary.


















### **History of ISSP**

- The ISSP was formed at the BHU, Varanasi in 1984.
- The formation of the society was initiated by the Dept of Anesthesiology but it was a multidisciplinary organization.
- Neurologists, Neurosurgeons, Orthopedics Surgeons, Nurses and other medical specialties involved in the management of pain were included.
- Dr. Akram Lal was elected as interim president and Dr. V. Rastogi as interim secretary
- Dr. Akram Lal attended the World Congress of Pain held at Seattle, USA in august 1984.
- During this congress itself, the ISSP was recognized as official chapter of IASP.
- The IASP and other office bearers included WHO chief of cancer Dr. Jan Stjernsward, took a keen interest in ISSP and promised to extend all support towards the progress of ISSP.
- Inaugural conference of ISSP was held in 1985. (150 delegates)
- An official representative of IASP and Dr. Stjernsward attended the conference.
- Dr. K. Pandey was elected as President and Dr. V. Rastogi as Secretary.
- Initially as per information from Dr. M.T. Bhatia, Ahmedabad--A small pain practicing group was formed in Ahmedabad, more or less, around the same time, when Dr. Akram Lal and Dr. K. Pandey from Varanasi formed ISSP.
- Later on, other pain societies in India were merged in the ISSP



### ISSP contribution in establishing Pain Medicine in India

Dr. V Rastogi Past National President, ISSP (1998 -1999)

Pain Medicine is relatively a new concept not only in India but also worldwide. The journey started with the introduction of concept of Pain Clinics and the Pain Research and Therapy by Dr. J.J. Bonica, the father of Pain Medicine. Initially the focus was on development of clinical services and Research in the Field of Pain and education. In Indian perspective evolution started with the formation of the Indian Society for Study of Pain at Varanasi on 7 July 1984 in order to bring Pain physician at one platform. Seven members representing different specialty Anesthesiology, Neurology and Neurosurgery laid down the foundation of ISSP. Inaugural conference of the ISSP held at Varanasi Feb, 1985 attended by Jan Stjernsward, the chief WHO Cancer Pain Relief Programme and John Katzs an IASP observer. Since then the ISSP successfully organized such event every year except in 1993 because of natural calamity of Plague and 1995. The Pain movement grew consistently but at slower pace creating awareness about Pain Management among the public and care givers and in the field of education. Pain clinics established by the members in Medical colleges and corporate hospitals. In a survey done by Dr. Rastogi in 1984 revealed only 16000 patients received treatment in various Pain clinic across India. The number doubled in next 10 years which was the result of increasing awareness and more and more Pain Physicians coming forward. I personally and on behalf of the ISSP acknowledge the contribution by the stallwarts of which few names are Drs K Pandey, A. Lal, MT Bhatia, S. Yajnik, Sushila Shah, Bibhuti Kalyani Das.

#### **Education & Training in Pain Medicine**

The need for structural training was felt and it was the year 2008, the Banaras Hindu University approved one-year Post-Doctoral Certificate Courses (PDCC) In Pain management and the first batch of three students (Dr. Nimisha , Dr. Narendra Pal Singh and Dr. Deepak Thapa) awarded PDCC degree. Two years later (2010) the SGPGI also started PDCC under the supervision of Prof. Anil Agrawal. More than hundred students awarded PDCC, FNB and DM degree in Pain Medicine from various medical Institutions /Universities.



Dr. Surange and team worked very hard on the project. I sincerely hope our efforts will soon bring fruits. It has been a pleasure to watch the ISSP grow from strength to strength in the last 20 years since.

### COMMUNITY SERVICE

### An opportunity to witness work of God through Man

As Pain Physicians, we are aware of the biopsychosocial model and its relation to pain. Many of us pain physicians work in metro and large cities. I used to wonder what would be the pain of rural, economically weak populations. An opportunity came my way in the form of a pain camp at Gadchiroli.

It is very rare that one gets an opportunity to witness the change in rural health in person. During our MBBS days, we had read about the abysmal IMR (infant mortality rate) of rural Maharashtra. We had also read about naxalism in Gadchiroli and the efforts of Dr Abhay and Rani Bang- an individual couple who were leading the change in our PSM books. In 1988, 121 new-born babies were dying out of every 1,000 births in the area. Dr Bang's solution was simple: he trained a group of local women in the basics of neonatal care. They were taught how to diagnose pneumonia (being uneducated, they count not count beyond 5; Dr Bang improvised and trained them using an abacus to count breaths), how to resuscitate children (how to use paediatric ambu bags) and how to administer some basic antibiotics. Instead of villagers having to walk for miles to get to the nearest hospital, these health visitors (called arogyadoots, which means & health messengers;) went to where they were most needed, carrying a small health pack on their back. As more women were trained, they passed on their knowledge to others and, according to Dr Bang, entire communities became & "empowered". So, when Dr. Jitendra Jain asked me if I was willing to go to SEARCH (Society for Education, Action and Research in Community Health) Gadchiroli for a medical camp for Pain, without a second's hesitation I agreed.

They established the tribal friendly hospital and a community-based healthcare programme in 134 villages in this area. The good work done by the Dr Bang couple has changed this feared town of Gadchiroli to a safe and beautiful place of healing.

They have started a multi-specialty OPD with a modern Operation theatre, trained staff and all necessary modern instruments. The Pain OPD is held on the first Saturday of every month. While conducting these activities, sensitivity to the mis-trust and fear of the impoverished and poor community was always a priority. Dr Band decided to build a hospital consisting of a series of huts that looked like a tribal village so that patients could stay with their relatives. To this end, the hospital looks like a village home from the outside- the walls look as if made from 'shen'/ cowdung; tiled roofs, a temple of the local "Danteshwari Devi" at the entrance to bless all who enter and use of local materials to make the furniture humble us as we entre this temple of healing.

I was overcome with extreme humility to see Drs Abhay and Rani Bang who have multiple National and International awards to their credit go about their daily work with the same zeal, love and dedication as when they were young. It was a divine feeling just to contribute something to this end.

The place Shodhgram, where the hospital and staff stay, was barren and drought ridden in 1990s. Dr Bang has changed this to a green lung with 3 big water reservoirs, overflowing wells and plantations of native trees to recharge the groundwater. The 'mess' or Shabari- place for meals – is common for all- the doctors, staff and guests. We have to self-serve the food and wash our used utensils for the next person to use. The rooms are simple, comfortable and bathed in the spirit of Khadi.





### ...COMMUNITY SERVICE

The OT doors, patient stool is made from Bamboo grown on the campus. I wish more of us made these kinds of hospitals in sync with our environment. I have decided to adopt the essence of khadi in my life.

Now about the work for which I had volunteered:

I went in July and December 2022. The SEARCH is 4-hour drive from Nagpur Railway station/airport. After reaching the campus, a quick breakfast and we took the blessings of Maa Danteshwari before starting our OPD. These were hard working farming population and their need for pain relief was aimed at being fit to work in the fields. They sought help when farm work was going to increase-just before the sowing season.

We saw 125 patients and around 25 needed interventional pain procedures. Our work started at 10 am and we finished at 10.30pm. We were exhausted but exhilarated at being able to help the farmer and local community to be relieved of their pain. It would be unfair to take credit for the small work we could contribute. The unflinching faith and innocence of the patients In us doctors has been possible because of the selfless work done by Dr Abhay and Dr Rani Bang since the 1980s. Their children too have continued this selfless work and have made SEARCH an institution we can admire and hope to emulate.

I am looking forward to further pain OPDs at this wonderful place.


