NMC UPDATE

Cover you launch webinar was done on ISSP Foundation Day on 9th July 2023. The video recording of the webinar is available on ISSP's You Tube channel for reference.

AYUSHMAN UPDATE

We had met Director HPQA, ABDHM, Dr Shankar Prinja twice during last year in May and November. We had presented our case to him and he suggested 2-pronged strategy to go ahead with it.

- 1) To add specialty name "Pain Medicine" in already existing list of Interventional procedures.
- 2) To list procedures not already added in the existing list, under "Pain Medicine".

His tenure as Director got over in March 2023. Upon enquiry with him, he assured us that in principle they had agreed to add Pain Medicine as a specialty in already existing list of procedures and it was sanctioned and forwarded to the concerned Dept. to be put on website. Unfortunately, this wasn't implemented by their new team and upon inquiry with him, he suggested to start fresh and submit our documents and claim to Ayushman authorities again. We had approached the new Director, Dr. Akshay Jain. Dr Pankaj Surange, Past Secretary was authorized to meet him in person. He had a very good meeting with him and presented all the documents in support of our application.

He assured that he will take up the matter with relevant teams and that name of our specialty will be added with the list of existing specialties who are entitled to do interventional procedures.

IAPM Exit Examination Jan, 2024

The IAPM exam is scheduled for 7th January 2024. The last date to submit the application form is 10th December, 2023. The exam will take place at Sri Aurobindo Institute of Medical Sciences on the Ujjain State Highway, near the MR-10 Crossing, in Indore, Madhya Pradesh. The exam will consist of two parts: a written test and a practical and viva voce test. The written test will start at 8 am and last for two hours. It will have 100 MCQs. The practical and viva voce test will start at 11 am and end at 5 pm.























ISSP contribution in establishing Pain Medicine in India



Dr. D.K. Baheti Past National President, ISSP (1998 -1999)

I had good clinical practice at Bombay hospital but still I was restless as something was missing. It was "RECOGNITION" as a doctor. The social scenario was different from PGI, Chandigarh. As the saying goes "Necessity is Mother of Invention. And the journey of Pain begins.

In 1991 I worked as International Scholar at Pain Management Clinic at Cleveland Clinic Foundation under chairman Prof. Stanton Hicks. After my return I approached the chairman of Bombay Hospital to allow me to start the OPD for Pain Clinic. At the first instance he asked me Can Anesthetist do something else. It was a shock and an insult to me. However, when he learnt that I have visited Pain Management Clinic at Cleveland Clinic Foundation, USA. He agreed to Pain OPD. At the same time, he clarified that it be without any renumeration for five years. That was a state of affair of thinking of management of hospital then.

I started Pain OPD and doing cases. My first case was of Ca. Pancreas needed Coeliac Plexus block. At Cleveland as we all know foreigners are not allowed to touch the patient forget about performing of the block.

Here, again one more saying "God Helps Brave and First time lucky" procedure was successful. The patient had good pain relief and when the next day I went for follow up he along with family were incredibly grateful. That was my First instance of RECOGNITION as Pain Physician amongst medical fraternity of Bombay Hospital and journey began. As an anesthetist I rose to become Professor and HOD, Dept. of Anaesthesia, Bombay Hospital Institute of Medical Sciences.

Now as academician I learnt about Indian Society for Study of Pain (Maharashtra, branch) To my utter surprise the affairs of the ISSP were run by Physician and Cardiologist. I joined the society and rose to the post of President, ISSP (National)-2000-01 Due to lack of proper education and training, and to update myself I continued visiting pain centers and attending conferences worldwide.

As the journey continued, I realized that there is lack of training and education in the field of Pain. I with the help of likeminded people formed the Pain Management Research Foundation-India and under its auspices we organized Six Global Update of Pain (2001-2015) every three years.

The team of Global Update of Pain has many "FIRSTS" to their credit such as conducting of Cadaver and Live Demonstration Workshops, Pain Awareness Program for Lay people, Pain Exhibition and conducting of live programs on State Television. Attending Global Update on Pain was not only Academic Feast but also learning of Pain Awareness for Lay people and how to conduct social programs. Till date many people cherish it.

During this period, I noticed that there is a paucity of medical books in the teaching and training of Pain Management. Our team Myself, Drs. Sanjay Bakshi, Sanjeeva Gupta, R.P. Gehdoo edited Interventional Pain Management, Symptom Oriented Pain Management, Interventional Pain Management and Atlas Interventional Pain Management.

I continue pain practice and my passion of conducting the Pain Awareness Program for Lay people.

In this journey I gratefully acknowledge the help of my mentors to name a few such as Drs. Subhash Jain, Sanjay Bakshi, Sanjeeva Gupta, L. Manchikantti, without them I would not have been what I am today.

PAIN IS INEVITABLE, SUFFERING IS OPTIONAL" – THE BUDDHA

My first exposure to pain management was in 1981, when I enrolled as a postgraduate student in the Department of Anaesthesiology at Safdarjung Hospital. I was assigned "Evaluation of Electro-acupuncture Analgesia in Acute and Chronic Pain" as my dissertation topic by my guide Dr Abhijit Bhattacharya. Every day between 2-4 pm in the Acupuncture Clinic I was subjected to both inquisition and astonishment.

As a postgraduate student, I was tasked with new patient's history and then gradually started treating patients with chronic pain syndromes. That was my firsthand experience to how miserable can Chronic Pain make a patient feel and how it affects the quality of life of the patient. Through successful patient reviews, I understood the importance of optimal pain management. At times, Dr R.S. Saxena used to treat patients suffering from cancer pain with neurolytic blocks via blind technique. As I finished my senior residency in 1986 from Safdarjung Hospital I was already familiar with the nuances of Electro acupuncture and TENS to treat patients with pain.

When I joined Sir Ganga Ram Hospital in 1986, the Orthopedicians and Neurosurgeons were the primary physicians to manage patients with chronic low back pain. The institutional convention was to refer the patient to the Anaesthesia team for a Caudal epidural block as we had the technical expertise. The job was done by us without going through the clinical indications for the same. Also, we never had further follow-ups with the patient as we were not the primary treating physicians of the patient.

Training at Long Island Jewish Medical Centre in Pediatric Anaesthesia, in the year of 1991 was a turning point in my pain practice. Now routinely used pediatric caudal epidurals, PCA pumps for post-operative pain relief were Novel by the then-Indian Scenario. A wonderful opportunity and my desire to learn meant a fruitful training session. The icing on the cake was the additional opportunity to observe Dr. Subhash Jain perform interventional pain procedures under image intensifier guidance at Sloan Kettering Cancer Hospital.

In 1999, Dr. G.P. Dureja organized a Pain conference and a live procedural workshop at AIIMS, where image-guided interventional pain procedures were performed by renowned pain specialists from all over the world. Back then, learning material for interventional pain relief procedures was hard to come by in India. Those were the times of pre-internet era, where digital learning material was not available as it is now.

I remember purchasing a first-of-its-kind image-guided pain interventions book at an international conference on Pain that I attended in Sydney. I have realized that more hands-on training would benefit my clientele.





So, I proceeded to Dr Sundar Raj's Interventional Pain Relief Centre, Nepean Hospital, Sydney for a month and learnt the subtleties of Interventional Pain Medicine. Once back home, logistical difficulties in procuring the only available image intensifier were playing a spoilsport. The solution for this was to use intensifier-guided procedures either before the start or after the finish of the Operative list. To further refine my skills in image-guided pain procedures I again visited Nepean Hospital in 2005. This helped to boost my confidence and furthered my clinical practice.

I was the first Anaesthetist to be permitted an outpatient chamber at SGRH. I began Acute Pain Relief Unit at the hospital and was the sole Anaesthetist to provide Acute Pain Relief services for many years. The Mechanical Infusion by Baxter with which I started services was slowly replaced by Electronic PCAs by CADD. Looking at the benefit that patients received from the pain relief services, the hospital assigned three full time nursing officers dedicated to pain relief services. We successfully implemented an Anaesthetist Supervised Nurse based Acute Pain Service Model at our institute.

As the work in Acute and Chronic Pain services grew, we were allotted a dedicated pain procedure theater. From there, necessary equipment like an image intensifier, radio frequency machine, ozone, PRP, monitors, Anaesthesia machine, and ultrasound machine were added gradually. Looking back at the difficulties I have faced in training in Interventional Pain Medicine, I initiated observer ships and fellowships in pain management way back in 2004 at our institute. A staggering number of both domestic and international interventional pain specialists of 200 or more have been trained by our department till date.

Due to the strides made in the academics of Chronic Pain Medicine, I was made the first Registrar of the Indian Academy of Pain Medicine (IAPM) and approximately 180 pain medicine fellows have been conferred with the prestigious IAPM fellowship. Taking it a bit up the notch, I was elected the President of the Indian Society for the Study of Pain (ISSP National) in 2022.Under the aegis of the Indian College of Anaesthesiologists, the Institute of Anaesthesiology, Pain and Perioperative Medicine at Sir Ganga ram Hospital has launched the Indian Diploma in Regional Anaesthesia (IDRA), of which I am the chairman. The young physicians' excitement for ultrasound-guided operations is impressive, and it will go a long way towards solidifying the importance of ultrasound in Regional Anaesthesia. In April 2023, we were approved our first Fellow in Pain Medicine (FNB) by the National Board of Examinations.

Through my journey as a pain specialist, I have seen a lot of peaks and valleys. However, the work unresolved, the patients knocking on my door due to the sinister pain and the unending process of learning still keep me going. As Lord Mahavira once said, "It is better to win over self than to win over a million enemies", I strive to be a better version of myself every day. I have been fortunate that God almighty has given me the opportunity to treat the pain and alleviate suffering.

(Written by: Ms Ruthie Paul...a childhood cancer survivor; suffering residual effects from the radiation therapy given at age 10 years during her developmental growing years.) She is a case of a childhood Hodgkin's Lymphoma; survivor with post treatment sequalae of radiation induced vertebral hypoplasia of right C5,6,7 vertebrae, tethering of apical pleura to right apex and severe atrophy of right sided neck and shoulder musculature making it difficult for patient to lie supine, severe bouts of coughing on neck extension, reduced strength of right upper limb due to Radiation induced post ganglionic brachial plexopathy with severe Right upper limb neuropathic pain.


