# ISSP UPDATES

## **Indemnity Insurance**

ISSP has come with a tie up with third party for medico-legal coverage of the members, under pain management category. This is the first time the pain medicine has been covered and members are now legally protected with indemnity insurance. The final proposal with all the benefits to the members and contact details have been uploaded on the website. Members are free to avail medico-legal protection.

## **Insurance coverage of MIPS I Procedures:**

We have completed the extensive task of costing and pricing of 129 MIPS I. The pricing report with packages have been submitted to “Insurance regulatory development authority of India” for their approval. Secretary had multiple meetings with top bosses of private insurance companies and Senior officers of Ayushman Bharat. So far, we have coverage and approval of the packages by Star Insurance the biggest health insurance provider in India. We are in talks with other health insurance companies and are quiet hopeful that we will be able to achieve this target soon.

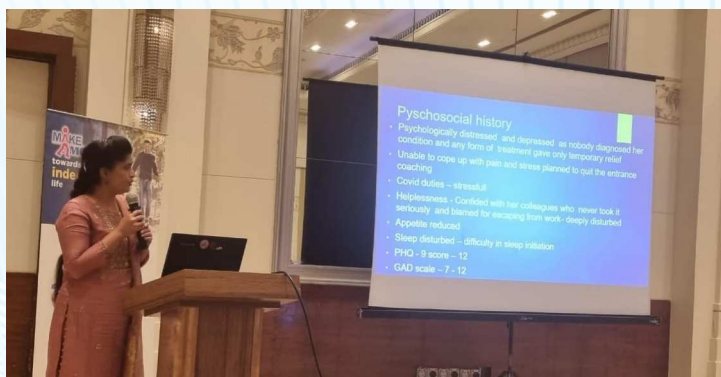
## CME ON CERVICAL PAIN ISSP KARNATAKA CHAPTER 1 OCTOBER 2021

### **USG HANDS ON CHRONIC PAIN WORKSHOP ISSP PUNE CHAPTER 17 OCTOBER 2021**

Society for Study of Pain, Pune (SSPP), recently conducted 'USG Hands on Chronic Pain workshop' on 17th October, 2021. It was conducted at Bharati Hospital, Bharati Vidyapeeth (deemed to be) University Medical College, Pune, from 8.00 Am to 4.00 Pm. The workshop was planned as Hybrid workshop, offline as well as Online, by following all the COVID protocols. Maharashtra Medical Council had granted special permission for this hybrid CPD and allotted two credit hours for the same.

Dr Sarita Swami, SSPP President and Organising Chairperson welcomed all the faculties and the delegates. Dr Varshali Keniya, SSPP Secretary and Organising Secretary felicitated all the faculties with the help of senior SSPP members. Dr Madhuri Lokapur, Trustee of SSPP shared her thoughts and the idea behind the workshop. Dr Sanjay Lalwani, Director Bharati Hospital and Research Center delivered an encouraging message on behalf of the University.
