

ISSP UPDATES



- <u>Insurance Policy</u> ISSP has a tie-up with Star Health Insurance for 14 procedure categories. The procedures are divided under day care and indoor, both categories according to patient's clinical condition. Other insurances like ICICI Lombard, GIPSA, CGHS, ECHS and Ayushman also discussed and ISSP office bearer are trying hard to convince them and under process.
- Indemnity Insurance An exclusive Doctors Risk Indemnity policy for ISSP members has been circulated through email and is also posted on official website. Parallelly other indemnity policy with Cover U is being explored. Multiple online communications and a physical meeting with Cover-U executives was conducted on 9th Nov 2022.
- <u>Life Membership</u> -Online membership is working well & members are registering. Total 2727 members till 25th Nov 22
- ID Cards disbursed till 31 st Oct 2022, new will be disbursed every month.
- The current GC members body has been updated to IASP and SARPS.
- Meeting was conducted with Hon Governor of UP, Smt Anandi Ben Patel, by Dr Pravesh, Dr. Hitesh, Dr. Anurag and Dr. Shivani Rastogi. Importance of Pain Medicine as a super specialty in all universities has been explained to her. Hon. Governor has suggested to follow proper channel and communicate with VC of University. The Secretariat has communicated through mails & letters with the VC'S of 3 universities (RMLIMS, KGMU & SGPGI) in UP.



... ISSP UPDATES

- Meeting with Executive Director (HP&QA), National Health Authority, Ayushman Bharat PM-JAY, Government of India, New Delhi, Dr Shankar Prinja was done. On 9th May 2022, ISSP was represented by Dr Pravesh Kanthed, Dr Pankaj Surange & Dr Anurag Agarwal. Very fruitful meeting was done wherein all the data regarding inclusion of Pain Medicine as a specialty with Interventional Radiology/ Neurosurgery & addition of procedures not listed in Ayushman Bharat scheme were discussed. The NHA assured that our proposal will be discussed & implemented as per their policy.
- A follow up meeting was again done on 9th Nov 2022 with Dr Prinja in which ISSP was represented by Dr Pradeep Jain and Dr Pravesh Kanthed. NHA assured that the packages with inclusion of Pain Medicine will be rolled out shortly.
- National Medical Commission E-Mail and letter, both from ISSP has been submitted to NMC to recognize Pain Medicine as a super specialty and also to start courses in DM Pain Medicine under institutions governed by NMC. A physical meeting with Dr Vijay Oza, President of Post Graduate Medical Education Board, NMC, was also conducted on 9th Nov. 2022 at Delhi. Dr Pradeep Jain, Dr Pravesh Kanthed, Dr Naveen Malhotra and Dr Anurag Agrawal represented ISSP. We presented our claim of starting DM Pain Medicine as a super specialty of Anaesthesiology. We were patiently heard and assured of putting up our demand with their board.
- It has been suggested by GC that support letter, if requested by institutions should be given to individual institute from ISSP. The Secretariat is supportive of the idea & the society will back every member who needs any type of help from the Secretariat.
- Website and software upgradation is done from time to time. There are some names/ details
 of members, missing from the software. We request members to connect to us for any help,
 updation of their membership or personal details in software like phone number, mail ID and
 address.
- We are revamping our ISSP app. Once updated, you can login in it through your membership number and will be able to edit your details. We are also planning to do case discussions and live interactions through the app. We will furnish the details once these are available.
- A successful campaign was undertaken with participation from each and every member for World Trigeminal Neuralgia Awareness Day (7/10/22), Global Day against Pain (11/10/2022), World Arthritis Day (12/10/22), World Spine Day (16/10/22) and World Osteoporosis Day (20/10/22). The Secretariat shared creatives for each day and members added their own credentials and shared the same creatives on social media handles. The feedback received for this campaign were moral boosting and from next year, we will upscale our efforts in the field of patient awareness. Members can reach out to us if they have any other ideas for public awareness.


- West Bengal State Government officially has approved "Swasthyasathi" (government insurance policy) for most of the pain procedures in the state. And it has become possible only by the gracious leadership and hardest efforts of Dr. Subrata Goswami. Officially the government order was published in the month of August and it's now successfully working in the state of West Bengal. The link to the order is https://tms.swasthyasathi.gov.in/portal/SSPPackage.asp?dw=2 ISSP appreciates and recognizes the efforts of WB office bearers in general and Dr Subrata Goswami in particular for the same. Other states can also liaison with their respective state government officials to list pain procedures in their government health insurance scheme or Ayushman Bharat.
- ISSP Secretariat urges state chapter/ city branch President and Secretary to conduct a GBM annually and elections, no later than three years as is mandated by our constitution. To maintain uniformity across the country, the elections should be held in the month of December, so that the new executive council takes over by Jan. and represent their respective Chapter/ Branch in ISSPCON in Feb. The minutes of the meeting and activities done by the chapter/ branch should be communicated with the Secretariat so that they can be published in the newsletter. Annual returns of the society should be filed with the tax authorities and a copy of audited accounts should be sent to the Secretariat for their record.



New techniques, drugs working wonders in pain management

Diagnosing, treating and managing chronic pain, be managing chronic pain, be it due to smaller ailments like sports injuries or big diseases like cancer has become better, more effec-tive and long lasting over past few years. tive and long lasting over past few years. Developments in ultra-sound guided techniques have improved the diag-nostic aspects while using better drugs through nerve blocks have made treat-ment much simpler and effective.

In fact 'pain medicine In fact 'pain medicine' has emerged as a new sub-ject, a super specialty of anaesthesia, and doctors can now specialize in it through DM degree. The Nagpur Society for Study of Pain headed by new president Dr Sunita Lawange and secretary Dr Archana Deshpande has launched an aggressive launched an aggressive and vast plan for educating and vast pain for educating not just the anesthesians who specialize in pain management but also physicians, oncologists, onco-surgeons and neurol-ogists on when and where ogists on when and where to refer the patients with chronic pain at the right time. 'Manging pain -brightening lives' is the theme for this year's educative programmes by the national body, the Indian Society for Study of Pain which will be cele-brating its foundation day today.

brating its foundation day today.

Dr Sunita Lawange, the president of Nagpur Society for Study of Pain (NSSP) shared a lot of details on latest techniques for chronic pain manage-ment in patients. 'In last 4-5 years the ultra-sound is being used as the

most important tool for diagnosing the exact spot of the pain, "After identifying the spot of the pain we use 'nerve blockers' to relieve the patient of the pain. The blocks actually cut the 'pain signal' and do not allow it to reach the brain. This takes off the feeling pain from the patient," said Dr Lawange. The nerve blockers, which are chemicals which lock the pain signal, are injected at the spot after administering local anaesthesia by 'pain medicine most important tool for

administering local anaes-thesia by 'pain medicine clinicians and experts'. These experts now have their own treatment clinics where the physicians and

specialists can refer their patients with chronic pain. "The family doctors and physicians as well as spe-cialists need to be educated themselves to know when and where to send the patient for treatment of pain rather than putting them on prolonged medica-tions," said Dr Deshpande. Pain caused due to mus-

tions," said Dr Deshpande, Pain caused due to mus-culo-skeletal problems can be easily disagnosed and treated using intra-articu-lar injections, trigger point injections, dry needling and nerve blocks. In case of cancer patients the plexus blocks are used to treat the patient for debilitating pain.

Modern methods playing key role

Modern neuolytic agents and modern radio-ablation techniques have also

radio-ablation techniques have also emerged as good tools in managing the pain efficiently.

Dr. Lawange explained how modern imaging tools like CT robotics can be a very good tool for precise diagnosis. "All these new drugs and techniques have improved the quality of life of patients to a large extent," she added. Many diseases where thrombosis or blood clotting causes pain is intractable and continuous over a large part of the body, can also be treated by delivering medicines through catheter in the body, can also be treated by delivering medicines through catheter in the epidural or suprachnoid space instead of the traditional oral delivery. The appropriate combination of neuropath-ic drugs and their dosing with Newer range of opioids new drugs also help skip the use of conventional steroids. Post 'Covid-19' complications like pain in neck, shoulder, back etc due to pro-longed sitting in awkward postures at

an neck, snounder, back etc due to pro-longed sitting in awkward postures at home, depression due to loss of jobs can also be treated easily by pain medicine specialists.

specialists.

Some patients, especially women, have prolonged whole body pain with no specific cause or origin. They are manageable through medicines and counselling and exercise in pain clinic. Dr Deshpande said that people with herpetic neuralgia keep suffering from years, but now they can get relief with neuropathic medicines and specific nerve blocks.

Citing an example of a woman who had been suffering from unbearable had been suffering from unbearable facial pain called as 'trigeminal neural gesia' Dr Lawange said that she was relieved of all pain in just one dose of a latest form of drug. "Such are the wonders of newer drugs and techniques like radio-ablation," she added.

Dr Deshpande admits that earlier it was difficult to treat patients with infections caused post surgery but now even they can be treated.

However both pain management experts say that the pain management requires a team effort which includes coanseling, physiotherapy and inter-

requires a team effort which includes counselling, physiotherapy and inter-ventions at the same time.

"It is sad that the pain clinics are not there in government medical colleges and hospitals which draw a huge major-ity of patients. Government needs to take up the issue seriously and adopt immediate measure to train its doctors in pain rediction. I am a destry from immediate measure to train its doctors in pain medicine. I am a doctor from community medicine and hence I would advocate that government considers pain as a public health issue and acts accordingly," said Dr Prakash Deo, the president of Nagpur branch of Indian Medical Association.

The IMA president, also stressed on the need for including pain in the insurance schemes run by both government and private agencies. "Such experts in pain management can also be trained and posted at district hospitals," he said.


