Hon. Secretary Dr Pravesh Kanthed informed the house about various decisions and action taken during last AGBM.

Agenda No: AGBM-04/23: ISSP Secretariat – Secretary's Report

Secretary Report:

Hon. Secretary Dr Pravesh Kanthed informed the house about various decisions and action taken during last year, since April 2022

1. Hon. Secretary updated regarding Star Health policy for insurance coverage. At present, only 14 procedures are included in Interventional pain management category by star health. The advanced complex procedures are still not included. Members are of the opinion to pursue the matter further with Star insurance to incorporate all the listed procedures under insurance cover. Dr Pankaj Surange updated the GC that around 19 lakhs have already been paid to Mr. Manivannan (our consultant for getting this work done) for the same and around 5% payment

- was still due to him. It was further decided to approach Mr. Manivannan to reinitiate the talks with other insurance companies to cover all the listed pain procedures under insurance cover. He needs to be reminded that as per the agreement, he had to liaison with at least 2 insurance companies.
- 2. Indemnity insurance by Cover U. They are ready to give indemnity cover for all 140 procedures (plus any procedure that will be added in future) listed in ISSP coding document. However, clarification was needed regarding nomenclature used in the MOU by the insurance company. Hon. Secretary to go ahead with the MOU after clarifying the nomenclature.
- 3. Regarding Ayushman Bharat, the secretariat is following up for list of procedures to be included in the policy with competent authorities.
- 4. Meeting was conducted with Hon Governor of UP Mrs Anadi Ben Patel, by Dr Pravesh, Dr. Hitesh, Dr. Anurag and Dr. Shivani Rastogi. Importance of Pain Medicine as a super specialty in all universities has been explained to her. Hon. Governor suggested to follow proper channel and communicated with VC of University. Dr Pravesh Kanthed has communicated through mails & letters with the VC'S of 3 universities (RMLIMS, KGMU & SGPGI) in UP.
- 5. Meeting with Executive Director (HP&QA), National Health Authority, Ayushman Bharat PM-JAY, Government of India, New Delhi, Dr Shankar Prinja was done. ISSP was represented by Dr Pravesh Kanthed, Dr Pankaj Surange & Dr Anurag Agarwal. Very fruitful meeting was done wherein all the data regarding inclusion of Pain Medicine as a specialty with Interventional Radiology/ Neurosurgery & addition of procedures not listed in Ayushman Bharat scheme was discussed. The NHA assured that our proposal will be discussed & implemented as per their policy.
- 6. National Medical Council Mail and letter, both from ISSP has been submitted to NMC to recognize Pain Medicine as a specialty and also to start DM Pain Medicine. It has been suggested by GC that support letter, if requested should be given to individual institute from ISSP. Dr Pravesh Kanthed informed that the Secretariat is supportive of the idea & the society will back every member who needs any type of help from the Secretariat. NMC recognition is the need of the hour and Dr Hitesh Patel was requested to follow up for an appointment with the concerned authorities (specially MoH & FW) to recognize Pain Medicine as a super specialty and to start DM (Pain Medicine) courses under NMC
- 7. Laptop received by the past Secretariat was of very old configuration & slow speed hence budgetary provision was requested to buy a new laptop and passed in last GC meeting. Bought new laptop by secretariat.
- 8. Website upgradation and software care will be done. Funds for this activity are passed as needed.
- 9. To maintain uniformity ISSP Helpline number is generated as **8889998301**. Whatsapp communications will be available on the same. This number will be passed to the next secretary to secretary.
- 10. 10th to 16th October 2022 was celebrated as Pain Awareness Week again including 11th October as World Pain Day. Secretariat gave various creatives for each day

- which were circulated by majority of members on their social media handles which created a big impact.
- 11. IASP Conference representation was done by Dr. Pradeep Jain, Prof. Ashok Saxena, Dr. Jeetinder, Dr Babita Ghai Dr. Hammad Usmani. Prof Ashok Saxena was bestowed with IASP award for excellence in Pain research in developing countries.
- 12. New member addition: Total number of ISSP members till 27th Jan 2023 was 2785. 174 new members added after last ISSPCON. Till today during this conference, the number has increased to 2800.
- 13. It was unanimously decided that the new members of ISSP that will join ISSP after the date of notification of elections will not be able to vote that year in AGBM. This will be announced in newsletter also.
- 14. Twitter account (@issphq) has been started by ISSP Secretariat and it was requested to all GC members to follow it.
- 15. ISSP Newsletter will now be released twice in a year, instead of once.
- 16. A Condemnation committee was formed and members of the committee will be Vice President, Past Secretary, Treasurer, Joint Secretary and senior most members of GC (any three out of five) along with President and Secretary
- 17. The current GC members body has been updated to IASP and SARPS.
- 18. ISSP Registration renewal is due in May 2023 at Varanasi, Hon. Secretary with the help of Dr. Muralidhar Joshi will proceed for the same.
- 19. Database updation is being done. 216 members were added to membership software who were missing in software. Also informed to chapter/branch Secretaries to share updated members details.
- 20. Constitution review committee under Dr. Muralidhar Joshi has given their final draft, it will be posted on website after finalizing it.

• Dr Hitesh Patel presented the unaudited accounts received from the Past Treasurer from 1st April 2022 to 27th Jan 2023.

- Dr. Hitesh Patel informed about transfer of account from Canara Bank, Dwarka to Canara Bank, Indore.
- Treasurer informed about the bank balance and FD records.
- We were registered under Section 12AA of Income Tax Act. However, the ITR for financial year 2021-22 was filed without availing the exemption. After enquiring with previous CA firm, we were informed that because of late audit and last date of IT Return, the exemption could not be availed. Further the 12AA was taken as a provisional exemption but no application was filed to claim the permanent exemption. Hence as of now, our society is not registered under 12AA.
- AS PER THE AUDIT REPORT OF FINANCIAL YEAR 2021-22, the amount receivable from Wolter Kluwer India is Rs 8,63,265.69. However, after doing correspondence with the company, as per their ledger, we were informed that there is no such receivable due towards ISSP at their end. So, we need to do this technical correction in our book of accounts.
