Obituary to our Founder President Prof. Akram Lal Sahab..

A Founder, Mentor, and Pioneer — his legacy will live on forever in our hearts and work.







Professor Akram Lal Sahab

(1-3-1939 To 22-5-2025)

Born in Rupapur, Varanasi on 1 March 1939 was a true son of the soil.

After his initial education from Varanasi, he joined the first batch of MBBS from GSVM Medical college in 1956.

He was the first post graduate student of Anesthesiology Department of IMS, BHU, in 1961 under Prof Phool Chandra and became a faculty in the same in 1963.

He along with Prof V Rastogi co-founded the Indian society for study of Pain in 1984 and also toiled to get the society recognized at an international level as the Indian Chapter of IASP, the International Society for study of Pain .

He also started the Indian Association of Palliative Care along with Prof K Pandey in 1994. He was the editor of Indian Journal of Anesthesiology for over a decade! (1980s -90s).

Was elected as the president of Indian Society of Anesthesiology in 2004-05 Established the Anesthesiology research lab in IMS, BHU and toiled to equip the Was the HOD of the department. Worked as an NHS consultant from 1967 to 2002.

Founder Principal of Haldwani Medical College 2002-2004department with latest equipment's of his times through his students overseas.

Recently he was pivotal in establishment of the Phool Chandra Block in Anesthesiology department in SS Hospital negotiating a fund of 100,000 US dollars from Professor Phool Chandra, his teacher and the establisher of Anesthesiology Department, to form a block and research lab in the department. He also used his influence on the global level to recommend the aluminums of Anesthesiology, IMS, BHU to be placed internationally in various institutions in UK,Canada and USA.

 Pass percentage is 50% and the candidates will have to secure 50% in each category i.e Written exam, Viva and Practical exam.

FIAPM Exit Exam Prerequisite Information

 Application for IAPM Exit Examination can be submitted under 4 categories. IAPM Category, Non-IAPM Category, One-year Fellowship outside India Category, Senior Pain Physicians Category. The eligibility Criteria are as follows.

Common requirements for all Categories

- Medical License: Candidates applying for the exit examination should have a valid unrestricted medical license, they need to submit a copy of NMC/ SMC registration.
- Membership of ISSP: Candidates applying for the exit examination should have ISSP Membership. Associate members of ISSP or candidates who are not Anesthesiology postgraduates (MD, DA or DNB in Anesthesiology) cannot appear for the exams.
- Publication Candidates applying for the exit examination should have the publication in chronic pain.
- Post-Graduation Certificate in Anesthesiology (MD Anesthesiology, Diploma in Anesthesiology or DNB in Anesthesiology)

Category wise Additional requirements

IAPM Category

- Trainees of IAPM who have entered IAPM-accredited training centers through the IAPM Entry Examination and completed a full year of Training in IAPM-accredited centers.
- One publication is mandatory on chronic pain. (In the Indian Journal of Pain)3

Non-IAPM Category

- One-year full-time residential fellowship programme in Pain Medicine from any Private organization, the program head of the said program should be FIAPM qualified.
- Structural program fellow from an Indian university (Completed a fully residential university-accredited structured pain training program of minimum one-year duration and passed successfully)
- One publication is mandatory on chronic pain.3





One-year Fellowship Outside India Category

- Completed full residential fellowship outside India of minimum 1-year duration & currently practicing in India.
- One publication is mandatory on chronic pain.3

Senior Pain Physicians Category

- ISSP membership for at least 5 years
- Two publications are mandatory on pain, at least one of the publications must be on chronic pain. 3
- Recommendation letter from GC member of ISSP/IAPM. (Recommendation letter will include duration of pain practice, number of patients in pain OPD & procedures) it should be on official letterhead with the physical signature of the member.

- The publications that have already been published will be considered only, not those under acceptance. Exception Only for IAPM trainees (Manuscript submission letter in Indian Journal of Pain)
- Publications must be in a Peer Reviewed Journal or Book Chapters.
- Publications in the conference books will not be accepted.

4. Cancellation Policy - Once approved by the review committee Exam fee is non-refundable
